

What to Do in Lanzarote

A 5-day guide with real prices



Lanzarote is Mars with beaches: freshly-sleeping volcanoes, vineyards planted in ash and César Manrique's fingerprints on every corner. This 5-day plan sorts the essentials through the island's best-rated excursions, real prices included.

Your 5-day plan

Day
1

Timanfaya, the fire park

Timanfaya National Park can only be visited on organised routes: the classic trip costs €59, and the full-day version (€75) adds Jameos del Agua, El Golfo and the La Geria vineyards. The geothermal demonstrations – water shooting out of the ground – stay with you.

Day
2

Kayaking to the Papagayo beaches

The island's prettiest coves, seen from the water: a guided kayak and snorkel route along the Los Ajaches cliffs to Papagayo (€50 with photos and snacks). Beginner-friendly and hard to beat as a day at sea.

Day
3

La Graciosa, the eighth island

Cross to La Graciosa: ferry with activities from €69 or a full day under sail (€67). Sand streets, untouched beaches and zero traffic lights – the Canarian Caribbean is 30 minutes from Órzola.

Day
4

Manrique's universe (and a family plan)

Give a day to the artist who saved the island: Jameos del Agua and Cueva de los Verdes, two caves of the same lava tunnel turned into art. Travelling with kids? Rancho Texas Park (€36), with its sea lions and water slides, is the day they will ask to repeat.

Day
5

Volcanoes your way, sunset at sea

Choose your last day: a buggy tour between volcanoes (€130, the most powerful ride on the island) or a calm farewell on the sunset dolphin cruise (€49) from Puerto Calero.

Local tips

- Wind is part of the island: book sea activities for the morning.
- La Geria: try the volcanic malvasía at any roadside winery.
- Timanfaya sells out – book the excursion 3-4 days ahead.
- La Graciosa has no paved roads: bring cash and comfortable shoes.
